The Mount Vernon Genealogical Society (MVGS) Research Center is located in Room 214 of the Hollin Hall Senior Center, 1500 Shenandoah Road, Alexandria, Virginia 22308, about four miles north of Mount Vernon Plantation in Fairfax County. The Research Center is open Tuesday through Thursday, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., with the following exceptions: closed the first Wednesday of each month for the MVGS Board meeting and closing at noon on the third Tuesday of each month for the general program meeting.
